Message of Invitation to the PARISH HARAMBEE

FOR THE CHURCH BUILDING On Sunday 9th March 2014

Saint Mark Catholic Parish of Ol Moran (Laikipia County) is planning for a 'Harambee' to fundraise the completion of the main Parish Church building. The Harambee will be held on Sunday 9th March 2014.

History and Mission of Ol Moran Parish

Ol Moran Parish was started in 1997. In these 17 years the Parish has been a prominent institution dedicated to the spiritual growth of the local community, but also committed to promote and support development projects. In good cooperation with many stake-holders, the Parish played an essential role of assistance during tribal clashes, as well as worked for reconciliation process and peace-building initiatives. The Parish has always been of effective support to people challenged by drought or famine, through aid-projects like "Food for Work" and the Parish Dispensary. Most of all, the Parish has always been on the front-line for the development of the schools and the education of the young generations.

We also believe that all this is not just history, but even our actual commitment, responsibility and mission.

The Project of the Parish Church

The building of the Parish Church has a fundamental value for religious life, but at the same time it is highly relevant to



the local society: in fact, this project affirms the stability and mature presence of the Parish, encouraging the Christian Community to be even more dedicated to the area where we live. We wanted it to be a land-mark that inspires beauty and spirit of identity.

The construction started on 1st November 2012. Foundation and walling have been already completed. We are now working at the trusses and roofing. Main works are

expected to be completed by May 2014. The Local Community has already contributed with funds, goods and works in order to sustain the costs of the building. On 27th November 2011 we had a major Harambee for starting the project. Other funds were received from friends and donors who wished to contribute. A special support was received by the Diocese Patriarchate of Venice (Italy). Now we intend to involve again friends and well-wishers in the next Harambee 2014 to be able to complete the project and clear the expenses. Our target is to collect KShs 8 millions. The Parish Church has been designed by the Italian Architect Stefano Battaglia, from Venice (Italy). The works are entrusted to Robkam Building Contractors, from Nyahururu. The New Church will be dedicated to the Patron of the Parish, Saint Mark the Evangelist, the first evangelizer, bishop and martyr of the continent of Africa.

Katika Mkutano wa Jumamosi 25 Januari, PPC iliamua kugawa Sehemu ya Kaskazini ya Parokia kuwa "Mt. Yohane wa 23 Zone". Katika sehemu hiyo kuna hasa makanisa mapya ambapo Parokia imejitolea kuleta Uenezaji wa Kwanza wa Injili (Nagum, Dam Mbili, Ol Donyo Ariwo, Kanjul, Lounyek). Yohane wa 23 (Angelo Roncalli) alikuwa Papa ali-

yeanza Mtaguso Mkuu wa 2 wa Vatikani, yaani mkusanyiko wa Maaskofu wote wa dunia, ulioendeleza zaidi kazi ya Uenezaji wa Injili katika dunia ya kisasa. Pia, kabla ya kuwa Baba Mtakatifu, Angelo Roncalli alikuwa Patriarka wa Venisi, Jimbo rafiki na mfadhili ya Parokia yetu. Atatangazwa kuwa Mtakatifu Jumapili 27 Aprili 2014. Hapa twaweza kusoma habari kuhusu maisha ya Yohane wa 23.

Pope John XXIII (25 November 1881 – 3 June 1963), born **Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli**, was the head of the Roman Catholic Church from 28 October 1958 to his death in 1963.

Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli was the fourth of fourteen children born to a family of sharecroppers that lived at Sotto il Monte, a village near Bergamo, in Lombardy (Italy). He was ordained a **Priest** in 1904 and **Bishop** in 1925, serving in various posts including appointment as **Papal Nuncio** in France (1944), Bulgaria and Greece. Pope Pius XII made Roncalli a Cardinal in a Consistory on 12 January 1953, and named him the Patriarch of Venice. Roncalli was elected **Pope** on 28 October 1958 at the age of 76, taking the name "John".

Pope John XXIII surprised those who expected him to be just a caretaker Pope, by calling all Bishops to the historic **Second Vatican Council** (1962–65), the first session opening on 11 October 1962. He did not live to see it to completion, dying on 3 June 1963 of stomach cancer, four-and-a-half years after his election, and two months after the completion of his final and famed Encyclical letter **"Pacem in Terris"** appealing for Peace in the whole world.

His passionate views on equality were summed up in his famous statement "We were all made in God's image, and thus, we are all Godly alike".

John XXIII made many passionate speeches during his pontificate, one of which was on the day that he announced the Second Vatican Council in the middle of the night to the crowd gathered in St. Peter's Square: "Dear brothers and sisters, returning home, you will find children: give your children a caress and say: This is the caress of the Pope!".

Pope John XXIII was buried in the Vatican on 6 June 1963. His successor, Pope Paul VI opened a cause for canonization for John XXIII. He was **beatified on 3 September 2000** by Pope John Paul II. Bypassing the traditionally required second miracle, Pope Francis declared John XXIII will be proclaimed a Saint based on his merits of opening the Second Vatican Council on 5 July 2013. He **will be canonized as a Saint**, along-side John Paul II, **on 27 April 2014**. John XXIII today is affectionately known as the "Good Pope". His **feast day** is celebrated on **11 October**, the day of the opening of the Second Vatican Council.
