Synod of Bishops for Amazon Region: Pope Francis calls for commitment towards Environment and Social Justice

## THE CRY OF THE PLANET

Pope Francis has called the Synod of Bishops to discuss the huge challenges of Environment, Evangelization, Social Justice in the Region of Amazon, in Southern America. The synod (i.e. the international special assembly of Catholic Bishops) will take place next October 2019 in Rome.

With this discussion, Pope Francis intends to address practically the matter of ecological deterioration of the earth, which must be considered as an issue of social justice. The destruction and exploitation of our planet and its resources is increasingly affecting world population, especially the minorities and the poor. Amazon Region is one of the clearest example of all that.

The Pope in 2015 had already written in his encyclical letter "Laudato Si":

*(2) Mother Earth now cries out to us because of the harm we have inflicted on her by our irresponsible use and abuse of the goods with which God has endowed her. We have come to see ourselves as her lords and masters, entitled to plunder her at will. The violence present in our hearts, wounded by sin, is also reflected in the symptoms of sickness evident in the soil, in the water, in the air and in all forms of life. This is why the earth herself, burdened and laid waste, is among the most abandoned and maltreated of our poor; she "groans in travail" (Rom 8:22). We have forgotten that we ourselves are dust of the earth (cf. Gen2:7); our very bodies are made up of her elements, we breathe her air and we receive life and refreshment from her waters.*



*(13) The urgent challenge to protect the Earth, our common home, includes a concern to bring the whole human family together to seek a sustainable and integral development, for we know that things can change. The Creator does not abandon us; he never forsakes his loving plan or repents of having created us. Humanity still has the ability to work together in building our common home. Here I want to recognize, encourage and thank all those striving in countless ways to guarantee the protection of the home which we share. Particular appreciation is owed to those who tirelessly seek to resolve the tragic effects of environmental degradation on the lives of the world's poorest. Young people demand change. They wonder how anyone can claim to be building a better future without thinking of the environmental crisis and the sufferings of the excluded.*

The theme of the Synod of Bishop 2019 for Amazon is: *New Paths for the Church and for an Integral Ecology*. In the Amazon rainforest, which is of vital importance for the planet, a deep crisis has been triggered by prolonged human intervention, in which a "culture of waste" and an extractivist mentality prevail. The Amazon is a region with rich biodiversity; it is multi-ethnic, multi-cultural, and multi-religious; it is a mirror of all humanity which, in defense of life, requires structural and personal changes by all human beings, by nations, and by the Church.

The Special Synod's reflections transcend the strictly ecclesial-Amazonian sphere, because they focus on the universal Church, as well as on the future of the entire planet. We begin with a specific geographical area in order to build a bridge to the other important biomes of our world: the Congo basin, the Mesoamerican Biological Corridor, the tropical forests of the Asia Pacific region, and the Guarani Aquifer, among others.

What is the Church's particular mission today in the face of this reality?
